General Terms & Conditions

1. Topic of these Terms & Conditions

The following General Terms and Conditions are valid in their German original version for any transaction between the Travel-Network – Christian Trede hereinafter called „Supplier“ and the clients of the Supplier, hereinafter called „Client“. The hereinafter mentioned „Tour Operator“ is the tour operator that is servicing the Client and is booked through the Supplier.

The Supplier works as a travel consultant and booking agent. The Supplier is not conducting any travel arrangements on his own (i.e. as a travel or tour operator) and is at such only conducting agent work. A binding agreement comes in place between the Client and the Tour Operator. This is not only the case for single bookings of single bookings, but also if single parts were individually put together for the specific Client according to the Client's wishes (no bundling / package by means of German law and ruling § 651 a Abs. 1 BGB, OLG Dresden, 27.11.2002 - 8 U 2423/01).

Some bookings and agent work can be done by partners of the Supplier.

2. Signing of a travel agent agreement

The signing of a travel agent agreement about the bookings and services done by the Supplier has to take place in writing by eMail, Fax or letter between the Supplier and Client. The supplier confirms this agent agreement also in writing by eMail, Fax or letter.

3. Payment and services

The payment of the Tour Operator services takes place as a prepayment / advance payment from the Client to the Tour Operator, if possible. This prepayment has to be settled in the amount and way prescribed by the Tour Operator (e.g. by means of a credit card payment). To simplify the process of paying individual Tour Operators, the Supplier can dictate the Client to settle the prepayment by means of bank transfer to a trust account in the target country. The costs of transfer as well as exchange rate fluctuations have to be paid by the Client. In this case, the Supplier promises to pay the Tour Operators in the name of the Client as soon as possible.

After settling of the prepayment / advance payment the Client gets Vouchers from the Supplier or original confirmations from the Tour Operators in order to certify the correctness of booking of Tour Operator services.

The Client has to pay the remaining amount of the total amount payable with the tour operator in the target country in the way described by the Tour Operator.

The services delivered by a Tour Operator depend on the service description of the Tour Operator and in consideration of the local conventionality as well as based on the information given in the confirmation and / or voucher. Subsidiary agreements that will change the agreed service have to be declared in writing without any exception.

4. Amendments

Changes / amendments of the agreed services / prices are subject to the Tour Operator discretion. The Supplier will give immediate notice to the Client about changes, once the Supplier gets informed about these amendments / changes.

5. Cancellation of contract

In the case that the Client wants to cancel the contract, the tour Operator can ask compensation. In this case the General Terms and Conditions and cancellation policy of the Tour Operator comes into place.

The Supplier will not ask a compensation of the Client cancels a contract between the Client and the Tour Operator; however, the Supplier is permitted to collect the compensation in the name of the Tour Operator.

If a Tour Operator is cancelling the contract with the Client, the Supplier will immediately inform the Client as soon as the Supplier gets informed by the Tour Operator.

6. Passport, Visa, Health

The Supplier is not responsible for informing the Client about passport, visa and health provisions and regulations as well as possible changes in these. The supplier, however, is obliged to inform the Client immediately about changes in passport, visa or health regulations and requirements.

7. Cooperation duties

The Client is obliged to inform fellow travellers about any information regarding the services offered and booked by the Supplier as well as other important information given by the Supplier to the Client.

Furthermore, the Client will inform the Supplier immediately if shortcomings and failings of the services offered by the Tour Operator take place.

8. Liability, Cancellation, Avoidance, Limitations

The Supplier is liable for the correct booking of services offered by the Tour Operator and according to the agreement with the Client.
